Amonov Mekhrojiddin Uzbekovich is the Head of the Scientific research department of the Imam Bukhari International Scientific Research Center. Mekhrojiddin Uzbekovich successfully defended his dissertation of the doctor of philosophy (PhD) on historical sciences on November 2, 2021 at the International Islamic Academy of Uzbekistan. On November 30, 2021, the Higher Attestation Commission of the Republic of Uzbekistan awarded the degree of Doctor of Philosophy PhD in the field of historical sciences, and on June 3, 2023, the academic title “Senior Researcher” was awarded in the specialty “History and source study of Islam”.

Mekhrojiddin Uzbekovich is the author of a number of articles, brochures and monographs. His scientific research focused on the life and scientific activities of Movarunnahr scientists, in particular, the teachings of Sufism - a number of tariqats such as Naqshbandiya, Yassawiyya, Kubrawiyya, Ishqiya and the scientific and spiritual heritage of their Sufi representatives. He also explores the history of rare handwritten sources, historical (court documents, waqfs, wills, irshads, etc.) documents, epigraphic monuments (mosque, mausoleum, khanaka, chillahona, etc.).
